PRESS NOTE

The Department of Food & Supplies, UT, Chandigarh, transfers the monthly food subsidy amount, directly into the registered bank account of the registered beneficiaries. The registered beneficiaries under Priority Households Category will get Rs. 128.64 per month/per member. The registered Antodya Anna Yojana (AAY) beneficiaries will get Rs. 900.48 per family per month. The subsidy amount is revised by Government of India from time to time. Due to outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic cases, there have been major shutdowns in the economy. To cater to the needs of the beneficiaries under DBT, the Chandigarh Administration has decided to release food subsidy for the month of May-2020 along with the subsidy of April-2020. The food subsidy amount for the month of April, 2020 & May, 2020, has been made available for the registered beneficiaries of UT Chandigarh. They are requested to check their registered bank account in this regard.
