ORDER

Whereas, an order No. DM/MA/2020/7293 dated 23-03-2020 in exercise of powers conferred under Section 144 Cr. PC was imposed in the District till further orders for the containment and prevention of the spread of COVID 19.

Whereas, in alteration of above said order to provide relief to the people and in order to ensure continuous supply of essential goods and services during the curfew period, the following exemptions are being allowed:-

1. One person from every house will be allowed to step out of their houses on foot between 10:00 AM to 6:00 PM daily till further orders, to visit their nearest shops or supermarkets selling grocery/Kiryana, fruits & vegetables, eggs, meat & fish, milk, chemist, etc which are hereby allowed to remain open during this exemption period for direct sale. Home delivery by all the shops will be encouraged.
2. To ensure unhindered supply chain of essential goods and services, all vehicles carrying/engaged in transportation or delivery of food items such as milk, fruits & vegetables, grocery, eggs, meat & fish, animal fodder, poultry, piggery feed, medical equipments, medicine supplier, ATM cash vans, LPG and Oil containers/tankers, shall be allowed to move freely.
3. For all these exemptions, the organizations/employers providing different services as also the citizens who move out must ensure necessary precautions against COVID 19 virus, as well as social distance measures, as advised by the Health Department from time to time.
4. The Executive Magistrates/Special Executive Magistrates deployed shall work as Incident Commander(s) in their respective local jurisdiction and be responsible to implement all the containment measures.
5. As a precautionary measure, children and Senior Citizens are further advised not to leave their houses.

This order shall be promulgated by the announcement through publicity vans and through press note for publication in the newspapers having circulation in the area.
