
ORDER

By Order No. DM/MA/2020/7293 of Deputy Commissioner, Chandigarh under Section 144, CrPC, CURFEW has been imposed in the Chandigarh on 23.03.2020. As part of implementation of this curfew order under CrPC Sec 144, urgent steps are needed to decongest the Mandi to ensure social distancing to prevent spread of COVID19. Thus, it is hereby ordered that:

1. Only half the vegetable and fruit wholesale shops (about 130 traders) will be allowed to open on one day. The other half to open the next day. Exact list to be prepared by Secretary Market Committee to ensure all vegetables on all days.
2. Only half of the wholesale Karyana and retail shops to open on one day. The other half to open the next day. Even shop numbers to open on even date and odd shop numbers to open on odd dates.
3. All other types of shops like bardana shops, gadda shed etc to remain closed.
4. Daily loading of approx 60 CTU buses for sectoral grid, that is managed by Municipal Corporation to be staggered in three batches of 20 each. 2 hours time to be assigned for each batch. Buses to be parked with ample space in between them.
5. Daily loading of approx 60 CTU buses for peripheral areas like villages, that is managed by Sh. Rupinder Brar and Sh. Harjit Sandhu to be done from CCET Sector 26 ground in two shifts. Concerned vendor to send trucks of vegetables like onion, potato, tomato etc. to CCET Sector 26 ground.
6. Mandi to have only one entry and one exit to regulate vehicles. At any given time only limited number of trucks and small canters to be allowed inside the mandi. This number will be decided on day to day basis as per ground situation. Other trucks and canters to wait for turn in adjoining transport area.
7. DSP East and DSP PCR to ensure adequate police force to be deployed 24x7 to restrict entry, exit and maintain social distance.
8. Four sector response teams to be provided for Mandi to enforce social distancing.
9. Number of rehri wālas/small retailers entering mandi at one time will be restricted. This number will be decided on day to day basis as per ground situation.
10. No individual customers to be allowed to enter the mandi.
11. No cars to be allowed to enter mandi at all. All cars to park outside in parking along Madhya Marg and in Sector 7 Madhya Marg parking.
12. Mandi to be closed for 3 hours daily in which Municipal Corporation to carry out thorough sanitization of the Mandi daily.
13. Chief Engineer to provide portable hand wash systems at various places to ensure hygiene. Chief Engineer to operate the two newly made toilets under MPLADs, for the period of this disaster.
14. No one to enter or move inside Mandi without mask or proper face coverage.
15. Health Department team to assess sanitary conditions in mandi on daily basis and suggest improvements.

This is issued on order and approval of Secretary, Marketing Board, UT Chandigarh. This order will come into force from 2nd of April 2020 and will remain in force until further orders. Strict action will be taken against violators, under IPC, CrPC, Epidemic Act and other relevant Acts.


